Donal Jaques Anderson passed away Sunday, October 10th, 2010 in Sandy, Utah. Donal was born to Nephi Alma Anderson and Zilpah Ricks Jaques on May 21, 1922 in Weiser, Idaho. When he was a small child his family moved to the Grande Ronde Valley in Eastern Oregon where he was raised. During World War II he served in the Army's 714th Railroad Battalion.
