Bret Jay Bodily, 71, passed away April 10, 2012 in Salt Lake City, Utah after a short illness. He was born in Preston, Idaho on February 18, 1941. He was the first child of Asa James and Alta Porter Larsen Bodily. He had two brothers, Bryce (Sue Ann) and N. Kevin (Peggy) Bodily, two sisters, Sharlene Dockstader and Lynette (Allen) Eddington.

He was raised in Fairview, Idaho, where he attended Fairview Elementary School, Preston Jr. High and graduated from Preston High School in 1959 and attended Utah Technical College in carpentry. He served a mission in South Africa. On his return he worked building houses.

In 1965, he married Jeanette Call in the Salt Lake temple. They made their home in Woods Cross where they raised three children, Darren Jay (Ilene) Bodily, Toni Kae (Donald) Adair, and Gregory C. Bodily. He worked as an elevator service technician for 25 years.

He achieved his one desire to obtain his pilot's license inspite of limited eye sight. He is survived by his wife, children, and eight grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and brother, N. Kevin Bodily.
