She is the eldest of six girls. Pam moved to Utah at the age of 19 and resided in Orem where she met the man of her dreams. She married MacArthur Halona on June 7, 1980 in Orem Utah. On April 11, 2009, a week before MacArthur's passing, they fulfilled their lifelong dream to be sealed together for time and all eternity in the Mt. Timpanogas Temple.
