Our loving Husband, Father, Grandfather, Brother, and Friend, Larry Lincoln Hanks, 69, passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 16, 2012. He was born on April 10, 1943, the son of Lincoln Hanks and Duella Opal Stevens in Tacoma, Washington. He graduated from Pleasant Grove High School in 1961. He served in the Toronto, Canada mission. Following his mission, he attended and graduated from Dixie College and then attended and graduated from Brigham Young University. Upon graduation from BYU he went to the Vietnam War, serving in the Army and later in the Air National Guard.

He married the love of his life, Kathleen Robbins, his college sweetheart, on September 1, 1967, in the SLC LDS Temple.
