**O**ur beloved Wife, Mother, Grandmother, Great-Grandmother and dear friend, Burdette J Powell, passed away peacefully on January 21st 2014 at home. Burdette passed on surrounded by her family after a long and very courageous battle with cancer.

Burdette was born on January 10th 1950 to Vern and Mary Jensen in American Fork, Utah. She attended school in Pleasant Grove and graduated from Pleasant Grove High School in 1968. There, she was active on the yearbook committee and a cheerleader.

She married George Almon Lux on July 18, 1969 and had 2 sons, Ryan and Adam Lux. George passed away in 1975 after a small plane crash. She married Don Harris in Las Vegas, NV 1977 and had 1 daughter Lisa Dawn.

She married Bryant James Powell on August 6, 1983 in Pleasant Grove. They were later sealed in the Salt Lake City LDS Temple. Together, they raised 8 children in Lehi, Utah. Burdette was then blessed with 18 grandchildren and 1 great-granddaughter, with 1 great grand-son due this June.
