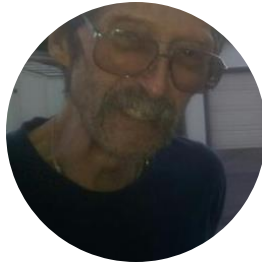

George Nicholas Luciano Romero was born August 2, 1943 to Nicholas and Edith Romero. Jesus called George home on September 17, 2014.

George was an Army Vietnam Veteran and after his Honorable Discharge, found his calling as a school bus driver for 21 years at Granite School District where he retired in 1995. He loved to watch sports, coaching baseball and each summer, he and his family would be found at the baseball park enjoying their family pastime. Winter sports kept him busy, because he had to keep up with his son Georgie at wrestling tournaments, and had to watch the Jazz and Broncos.
