**R**andall Carrol Rose passed away peacefully on December 5, 2013, in the presence of his family. He died after a struggle with cancer. He was born in Vallejo, Ca. on August 27, 1953. Randy was raised in Tooele, UT and spent many of his remaining years at his home in Pine Canyon. Randy is remembered for his wonderful personality, sense of humor, great athleticism, and love and appreciation for his Native American Heritage. He loved walking, playing golf, and watching sports. He will be missed by many who loved him. Randy is preceded in death by his parents Jones (J.R.) and Dorothy Rose, and his sister Karen Rose Eastburn Cato. Randy is survived by two handsome sons, Brayden Robinson, of Layton UT., and Hunter Campbell of Spokane, WA. He is also survived by his sister Cheryll & Husband Howard Hammond, of Winnemucca, NV., sister Ramona (Bankhead) Rose, of Santa Clara, CA., and brother Jerry and wife Lisa Rose, of Bountiful, UT., In addition to many other relatives. At Randy's request there will be no funeral services, although his family has planned for a Memorial to remember Randy.
