Faye was born September 12 1941 to Benjamin Lavar Hutchings and Lela Black, she's one of 13 brothers and sisters.

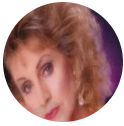
Faye was a strong and loving woman who endured years of pain and illness. Through it all she managed to keep her quick witted sense of humor and tried to the end to keep her spirits high.
