Bill Duscavage passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, November 21, 2015 at the age of 91. He was surrounded by his loving family as he returned to his heavenly home. He was born on July 4th, 1924 in Zion Grove, Penn. to Anna Marie Alkosky and Walter John Duscavage. At the age of 19 he enlisted in the Navy for the duration of World War II. While serving in Hawaii he felt a connection to the Islands which led him to settle down in Honolulu after the war. He spent several months traveling the globe in preparation to open a series of curio and jewelry shops in the International Marketplace in Honolulu.
