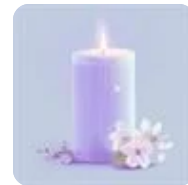

Nonie was a wonderful lady. She had a big and loving heart with room for everyone there. She will always be in my heart right alongside her sister Velda.



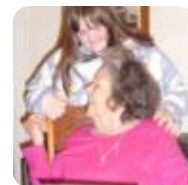
