**R**obert Waldo Hallam, 76, passed away Saturday, October 22, 2016 at Heritage Care Center in American Fork, Utah from the effects of Parkinson's.

Robert was born September 8, 1940 in Coalville, Utah to Waldo Robertson Hallam and Bess Laney Hallam. The first of six children.

Robert was raised in Emmett, Idaho. Attended school there and graduated from Emmett High. He attended one year at Utah State in Logan, Utah before serving an honorable mission in the East Central Mission. Attended BYU before joining the Navy to serve his Country.
