## Jennell Foreman Broadhead 1932 - 2017

Jennell Foreman Broadhead, age 84, from Payson Utah returned to her eternal home on February 1st 2017.

Jennell was born in Lehi Utah on October 14th 1932 to Martin Dewey and Jennie Bertha Foreman. She married Dee Warren Broadhead on August 12th 1959 in the Los Angeles Temple. She graduated from Lehi High School then continued her education at Brigham Young University where she earned a bachelor's degree in education and did post graduate work at Utah State University. She taught elementary education for two years in Colton, California as well as four years in Logan and Cedar Fort, Utah. Jennell served an LDS mission in Brazil, and was a lifelong member of the LDS church serving in leadership positions in the young women's program, the Relief Society, as well as various teaching positions.

Jennell was a dedicated wife and mother raising 5 children and influencing many more.

Jennell was preceded in death by her grandparents William and Ellen Taylor, parents Martin Dewey and Jennie Bertha Foreman, stepmother Dorothy Foreman, sisters Elaine Allan and Shirley Burnside, and grandson Austin Broadhead.
