## M axine Clarke Hillman 1923 – 2017

Maxine Clarke Hillman, 94, of Layton, Utah, passed away on Sunday, November 26, 2017 surrounded by family members at her daughter's home in Layton.

Maxine was born in Burton, Idaho, to John Roland (J.R.) Clarke and Nora Redford Clarke on April 8, 1923. She attended schools in Rexburg, Idaho. Maxine had a beautiful voice and loved to sing starting when she was very young and continuing throughout most of her adult life, singing at many activities and funerals. She loved many things - sewing, crocheting, cooking, looking for antique bottles, building miniature doll house furniture, reading, gardening, and spending time with family. 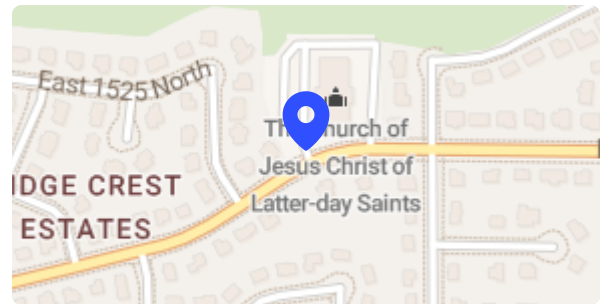
