Neil Franklin Charter, age 74, passed away, at home, in Layton, Utah on January 19, 2018, a few weeks shy of his 75th birthday. Born February 10, 1943, in St. Paul, Minnesota to Earl Franklin Charter and Anne Josephine Rubash. Married Joan Marie Wilson, on March 21, 1964 in Benton City Washington and again on August 9, 1995 in Kamas, Utah. Together they had seven children; Michael Franklin of Trego, Wisconsin; David Earl of Buffalo, Minnesota; Heath Andrew (Emily) of Fredricksburg, Virginia; Heather Anne Blank of Layton, Utah; Matthew Neil (Martina) of Layton, Utah; Elias Wilson of Layton, Utah and Seth Russell of Midvale, Utah.

Neil will be remembered for his love of hunting and fishing and for his impeccable work ethic of providing for his family of nine. We love you and will miss you.



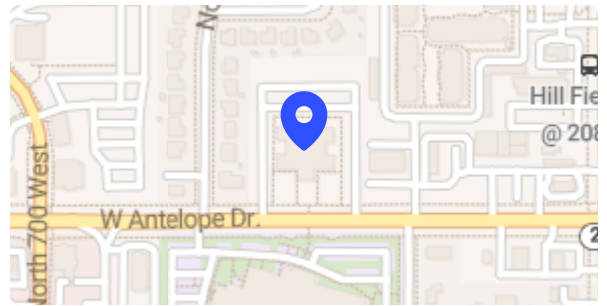

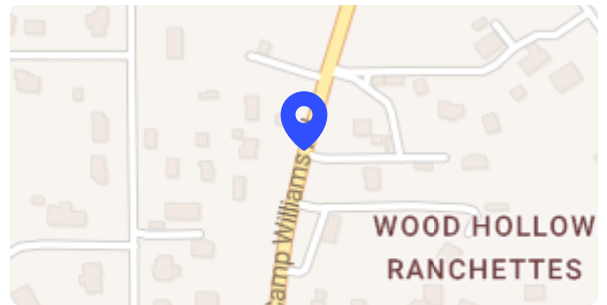
