She loved having people in her home. Almost all of her grandchildren, (and some other "strays") lived in her basement as poor, starving students or newlyweds. She charged a pittance. She just wanted to have them near. If you were lucky enough to be a guest in her home, you were privy to some of her famous spaghetti... probably 2 or 3 servings. She was tiny and feisty and wonderful. We were lucky to have had her for so long.
