It is with heavy hearts that the family of Abdool Hossein Shotorbani announce his passing on Friday April 27, 2018 at the age of 94 years. Abdool will be lovingly remembered by his wife of 61 years, Batool Tlooie, and his children, Nasser (Cindy), Khosrow (Kristy), and Solmaz (Erik). Abdool will also be fondly remembered by his five grandchildren John, Kianna, Stephanie, Kahlin, and Emilio Parviz.

Abdool was born in Tabriz, Iran, He was a self-made leader who lived with simple values and believed “others planted for us to eat, it’s for us to plant for others to eat.” He was a business entrepreneur and co-owner of Autosabet, an agricultural machinery business, until retiring in 1986.

He was preceded in death by his son, Parviz Shotorbani; and brothers, Mohammad Hossein Fardad and Hossein Ali Tahmasebipour. Abdool is survived by his brother, Gholam Ali Tahmasebipour; and sister, Malihe Samadi, and all his siblings’ loving families. He enjoyed mountaineering, gardening, and mechanical engineering. He was a passionate phytophile and philotherian—he loved all living things from a rose to the forest; an ant to the crocodile.

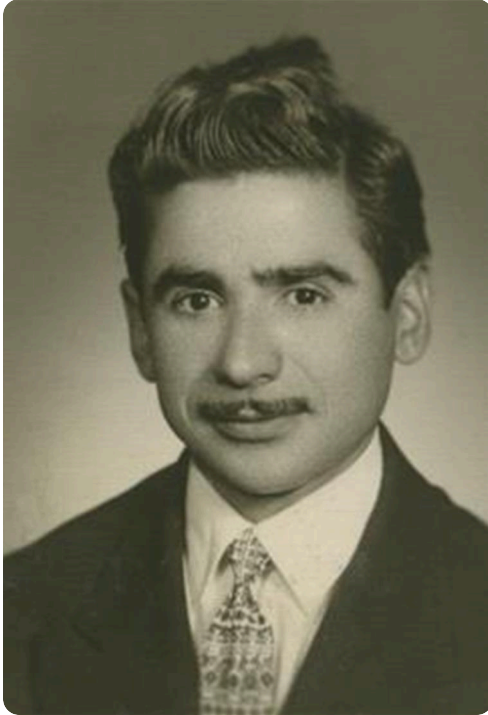
