Dorothy Eleanor Harris Raty, 89, our beloved mother, passed away on February 19, 2019. Services will be held on February 25, 2019, at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, 235 East Seego Lily Dr., Sandy, Utah. Family and friends may gather and greet each other at 10 a.m. followed by the funeral service at 11 a.m. Graveside services will be at Lindquist Memorial Washington Heights in Ogden.

Eleanor was born on July 6, 1929, in Quincy (Sawdust), Florida to Beulah Mae Chester and Thomas Benjamin Harris and was the ninth of ten children. Her lifelong love of reading started in early childhood, and her teenage years were filled with family, school, work, and an influx of servicemen to the nearby military base. She enjoyed the weekly dances, and eventually married one of the servicemen, Leslie Shupe Raty, a Navy seaman she met at church.

Eleanor and Leslie were married on December 1, 1949 in the Salt Lake City, Utah Temple.
