Cindy Ingalls lit a candle in honor of Donna.

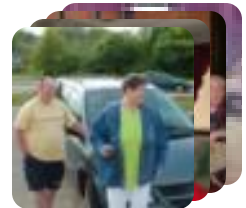

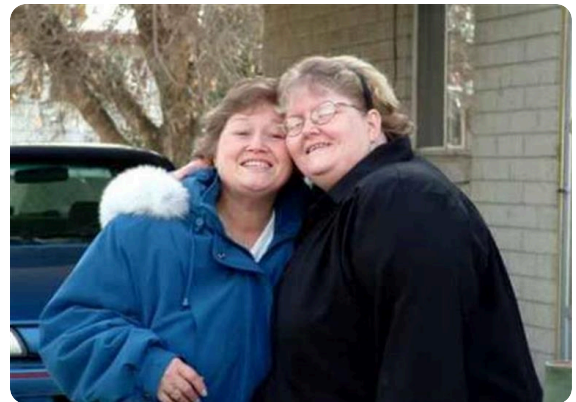

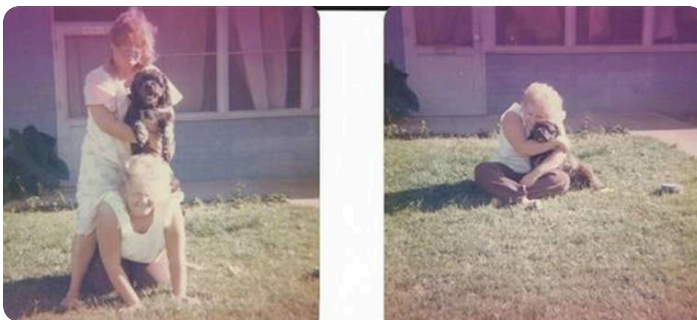
