## **Lisa Malan Lord**

**L**isa Malan Lord, 62, passed away on August 1, 2019 from complications due to breast cancer. She was born April 14, 1957 to Don T. and Jeanene J. Malan at Dee Hospital in Ogden, Utah.

Lisa was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Saints, and served in many capacities over the years. At the time of her passing, she served as an Ordinance Worker at the Seattle Temple.

Lisa had several careers during her lifetime, but her favorite positions always included working with children. Before she retired, she worked as a para-professional in Sequim and Port Angeles schools, where she dedicated her time to helping children with special needs.
