She was born May 8th, 1930 in Salt Lake City to Erma Floyce Wolford and Melvin Humpherys. She was born in the early morning twilight hour, which is how her name was chosen. Twila was raised in SLC UT by loving parents where hard work was a way of life. There were plenty of struggles and sacrifice growing up in the depression era. It was this upbringing that would establish her values and service to others for the rest of her life.

She graduated from Granite High School in 1947. During her high school years, she become acquainted with a young man named George Plant, who recently returned from WWII. 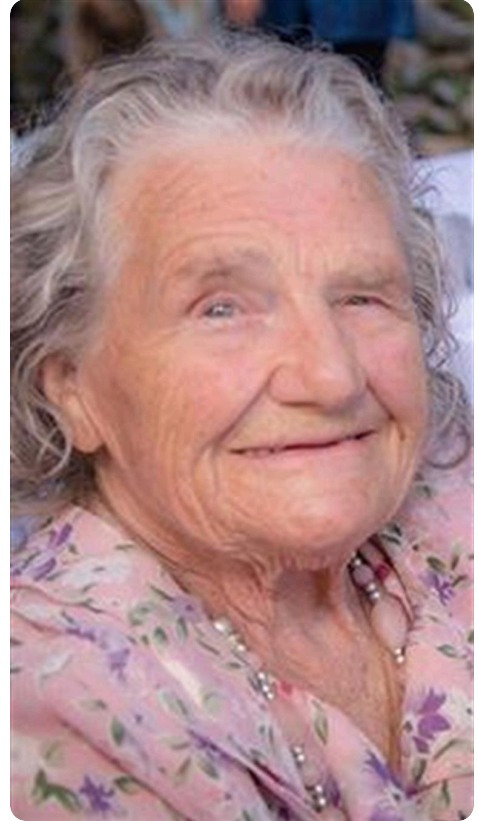
