On Friday, December 27th, 2019, Harrell Halman Smith, loving husband, father and grandfather passed away at the age of 81 in Ogden, Utah, surrounded by those who loved him most. His loving wife, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Harrell was born on October 24th, 1938 in Olney, TX to Elbert and Ada Smith. He graduated from Rawlins High School, Rawlins, WY. in 1957. On June 24th, 1961, he married Sharon Marie Mathill.
