Justin Richard Thomson passed peacefully at home with his wife by his side, on April 21st, 2020.

Justin Richard was born to Verno Justin Thomson and Loa Christensen on April 15, 1931 in Richmond, Utah. He attended Park elementary school, he was called Richard by family and friends. His siblings are Eldora (Anderson), Vernell (Harmon) (deceased), Harold Thomson, Leland Thomson. He married MauDee Bair October 8, 1962 in Logan temple.

Surviving are: Rick, Joel, Holly (Hiatt) and Alaina, his children and five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

He served in the Navy during the Korean Conflict on US Tassig DD 746. 2200 ton Destroyer. He was an electronic technician...radio man. He later served a LDS mission to the southern states, covering Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina.

He served in the bishopric with Bob Knapp (Bishop) Dad was first counselor and Jon Hirshi (2nd counselor) for 2 years. He had several church callings on the ward and stake level. He was a ward clerk many times he would ride his bike checking on people and addresses.

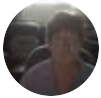

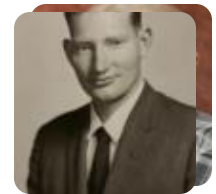
