Joseph G. Hamilton passed away peacefully February 26, 2021. He was born in Heber, Utah on May 29, 1929.

Joe was a millwright at Geneva Steel. He worked there for 40 years prior to his retirement.

In 1970, he married Judith (Judy) Leyshon. At that time Joe had 6 children and Judy had 3 boys from previous marriages. Their families were united through the birth of their son, Johnny Joe. Their marriage was solemnized November 10, 1990, in the Manti temple.

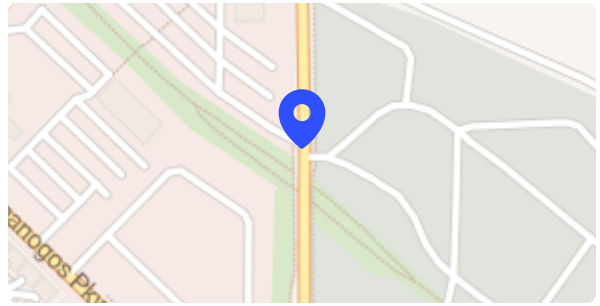

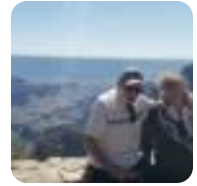
