Hollice Carroll Bunn passed away peacefully on March 30, 2021 at the home of her son Mark and his wife Doris in Ogden, Utah after a valiant, year-long battle with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS).

Holly was born in Oneonta, New York on March 9, 1942 to Edward Carroll and Grace (Ristau) Carroll, and was raised on her family's farm on the Susquehanna River between Oneonta and Otego. She graduated from Oneonta High School in 1960. She was predeceased by her parents, her sister Ruth Carroll, first husband Hubert Stevenson, and second husband Francis Bunn.

She is survived by her children, Laurel Stevenson (Wayne), Mark Stevenson (Doris) and grandchildren Ella and Sonja; step-children Terry Bunn (Debbie), Bonnie Moore, Francis Bunn, Toby Bunn (Nancy), Hope Jones (Richard), Casey Bunn and many loving grandchildren.
