She graduated from Mountain Crest high school in Hyrum Utah and later attended Brigham Young University for a year, then transferred to Utah State University and continued her education where she earned a Bachelor degree in Marketing.

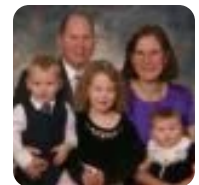
