Bruce Dean Blanke, 63 of Sandy, UT passed away suddenly of a fatal medical event, on Wednesday, October 27th, 2021 at his home.

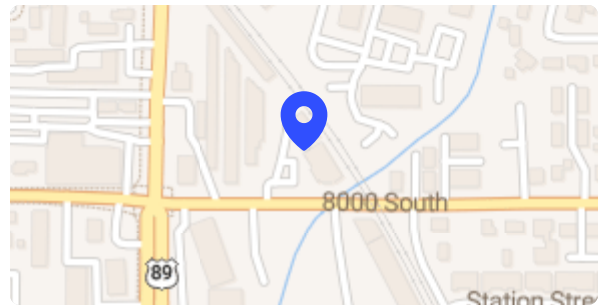
