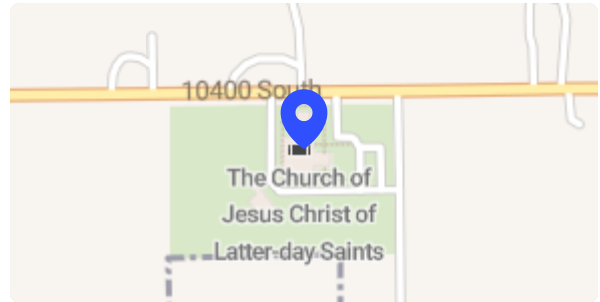

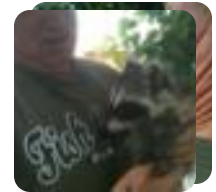
Cindy Carter posted:
