Guy Tannehill of Clinton, Utah died in a tragic car accident on March 18, 2022. He was 48 years old. Guy was born on March 30, 1973 to David and Judy Tannehill in Ogden, Utah. He was the middle child of David and Judy between Chris David Tannehill his big brother and Tracy Tannehill Hopkin his little Sss. He was employed by Hart 2 Heart Moving. Guy was very blessed to work for his best friend, Jason Hart.

Guy spent two years living in California where he became Avery's favorite uncle. He tried his hand at the East Coast and spent a year in Annapolis, Maryland, where he loved exploring the history of our nation. He spent over a decade in Oregon where he developed a love of deep-sea fishing.
