The family would like to thank his sister-in-law Eva Andrews for selflessly caring for John during his illness and for the kindness she gives to the entire family.

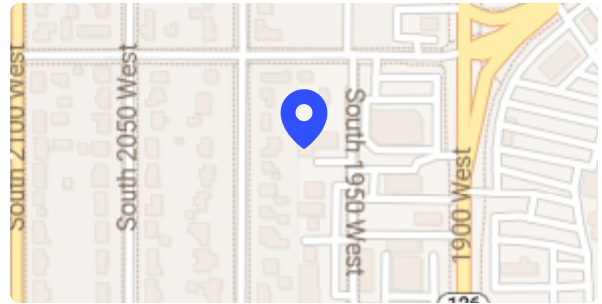
