Devan was born June 10, 1999, in Layton, Utah. Devan was a tender-hearted boy with a jokester personality. Devan was the life of the party but also one of the kindest souls you would ever meet. Devan was a boy scout where he earned the highest honor of Eagle Scout. Devan was a graduate of Roy High School. Devan proudly served an LDS mission in the San Antonio Area. One of his mission companions referred to Devan as a “sweetheart of guy.” Shortly after his mission he met the love of his life Cassie Jensen and they were married March 30th, 2020, in Roy, Utah. Devan joined the United States Air Force in October of 2020 and honorably served for two years after which he was medically retired. 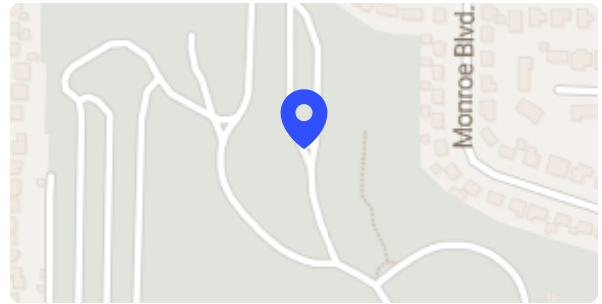

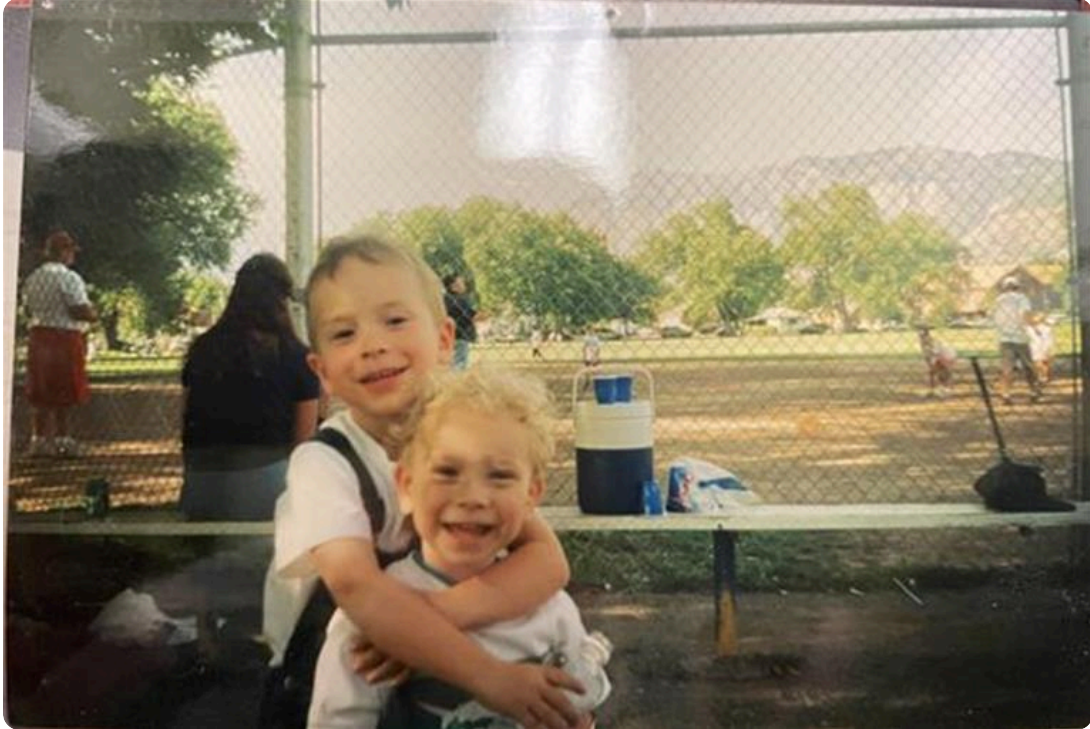

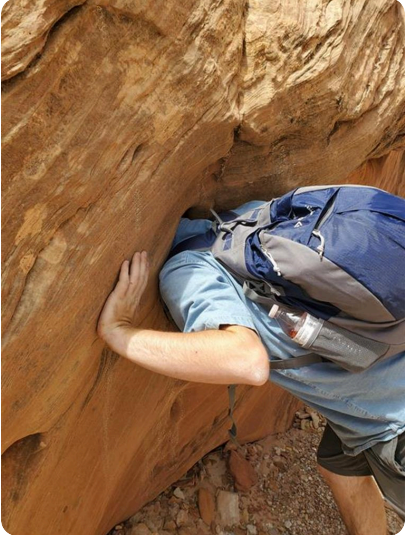
