Lynn worked for over 25 years at Kennecott Coppermine and retired from there as a Power Plant Operator. He also worked for Oasis Stage Lighting and was in charge of the light shows for various bands, travelling with them throughout the United States.

His greatest source of pride was his two daughters, Amy and Autumn. Amy's children are Sierra, Janessa, and Mala. Lynn also has great grandchildren, Mateo and Tianalei. Autumn's children are Isaac, Alyssa, and Gianna.
