LaRae (Flo, Nana) Nelson passed away in her home in Salt Lake City, Utah on March 27, 2023. She was in the presence of her eldest daughter (Angie Martinez) and her newest great grandchild (Mia Martinez) who were taking a nap as she tiptoed out the door to Heaven.

LaRae was born on her kitchen table in American Fork, UT on September 8, 1935 to Raynor and Laura Pulley Beck Larsen. During her early years, she worked to help the family at the Pulley Turkey Plant . She had all kinds of different jobs which resulted in LaRae hating turkey, even on Thanksgiving. Her next job was a little sweeter. As a teenager, she worked at Don's Sweet Shop where she worked the counter making hamburger's, fries, shakes and ice cream goodies. During the summers, she worked at the snack bar at Saratoga on Utah Lake.

LaRae attended BYU for one year before transferring to Utah State University where she received her Bachelors Degree in Elementary Education, with a Minor in Art. She loved Utah State where she was a member of Sigma Kappa Sorority and a Song Leader. Her favorite class was Econ 51, where she met the love of her life, Peter Morgan Nelson. They became college sweethearts. They loved to dance every weekend and hung out at the Bluebird Cafe.
