Bill Passed away on 8/26/2023 in hospital due to complications from a heart attack. He was surrounded by family and loved ones. Bill was born on 6/5/1943 in Salt Lake City, Utah. Bill attended Granite High school, and later joined the Navy in 1965 and was honorably discharged in 1971. While in the Navy Bill earned the Vietnam service medal and National Defense service Medal. He especially enjoyed working with Salt Lake City fire department and made many lifelong friends, He retired in 2009. He enjoyed doing many things but most of all he loved his dogs. 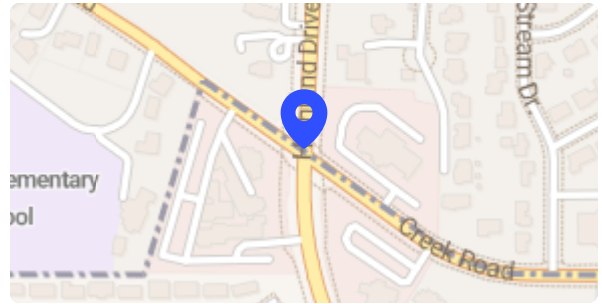

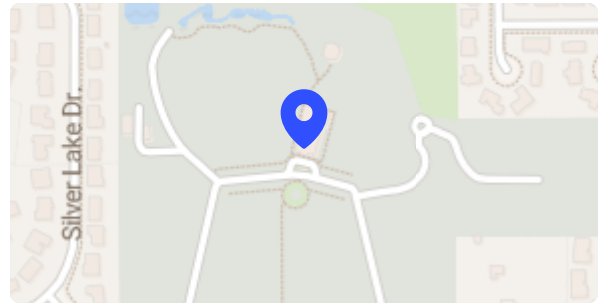
