Lawrence loved his country immensely; so first chance he got, which was right after High School graduation, he joined the Navy. He served as an airplane navigator/ controller on 2 naval ships & loved every minute of it.

Following the Navy, Lawrence moved to Utah where he attended Weber state University. After moving he met his eternal companion & sweetheart, Donna Nuttall. They were sealed for time & all eternity in the Logan, Utah temple on August 13, 1965 & had 4 beautiful children. He loved his family & would do anything to support his children or grandchildren.

Lawrence was one to expand his expertise & dabbled in a lot of things. He was an entrepreneur at heart, a business man, a leader, a teacher, a salesman & a professional speaker.
