There will be a celebration of life held in Kevins honor on Saturday, May 4th at 1pm in Willow Park for family and friends.




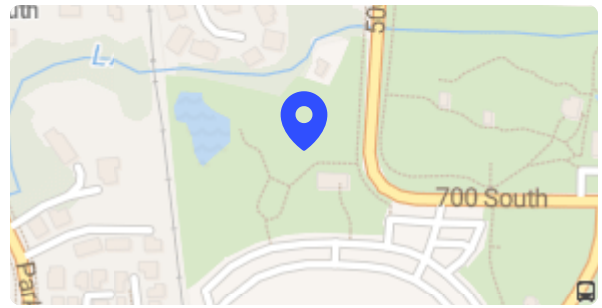
