Kent Lorenzo Marriott, 77, left this world on Tuesday, 28 May, at Ogden Regional Hospital. He was born April 22, 1947, in Ogden, Utah, son of Chester H. and Dorothy G. Marriott.

Kent graduated from Weber High School, class of 1965. Following graduation, he joined the Army Reserves while attending Weber State College.

In addition to Kent's parents, he was predeceased by his wife Sarah and three brothers: Ronald, Clark, and Stuart.

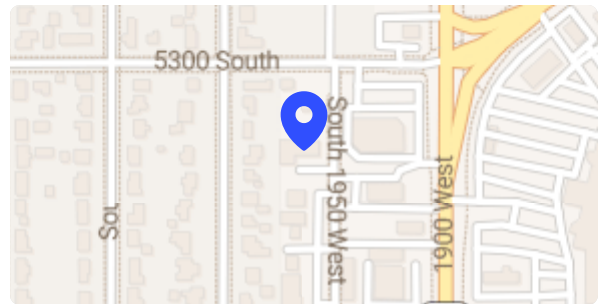

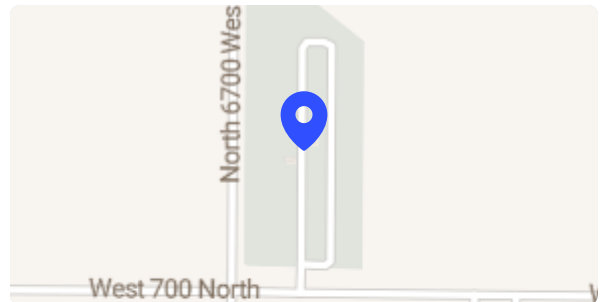

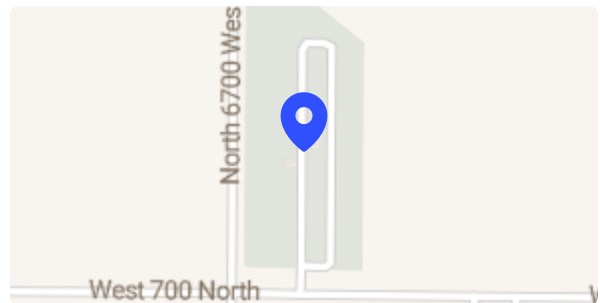
