Robert's warmth, humor, and zest for life will be deeply missed by all who knew him. His legacy of love and passion will continue to live on in the hearts of those he touched.

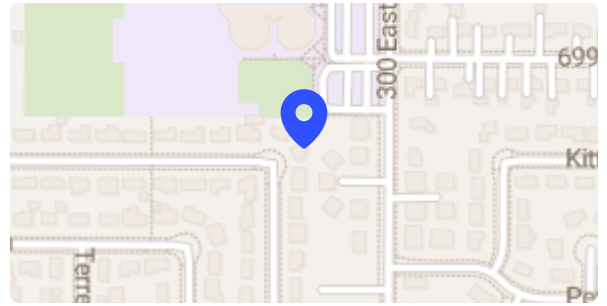
