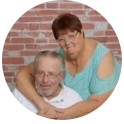
Robyn Eileen Jensen Wilcox 69, passed away at home on August 13, 2024.

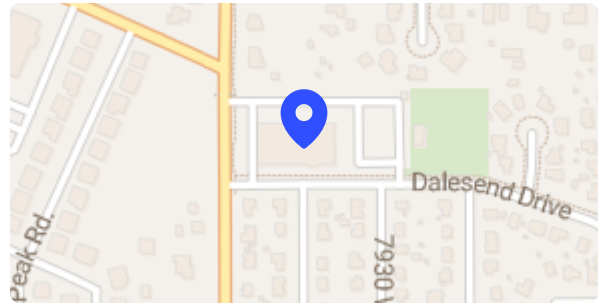
