Ron's legacy of love, kindness, and humor will live on in the hearts of all who knew him. He will be deeply missed but never forgotten.






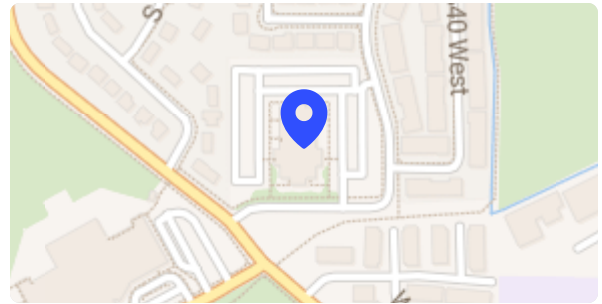

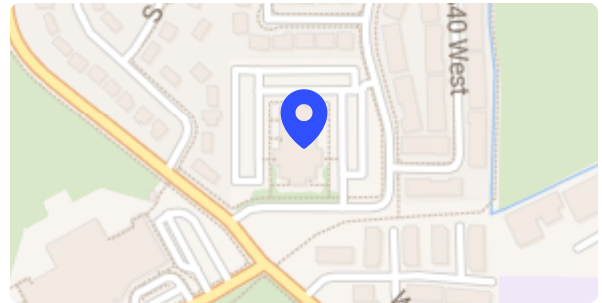
