Delores will be missed dearly by those who had the privilege of knowing her.






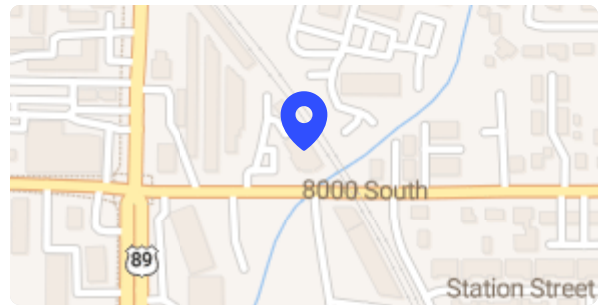
