Javann Owen (Nuttall) Wrathall, beloved mother, grandmother, and friend, passed away peacefully at home on 29 October 2025, surrounded by her loving family. She was 91 years old.

Born on 25 October 1934 in Rigby, Idaho, to Vincent and Lucile Owen, Javann spent her childhood surrounded by family and the simple joys of rural life. She later moved with her mother and sisters to Jackson, Wyoming, where she developed a love for the outdoors, spending carefree summers exploring, fishing, and camping. The family eventually settled in Idaho Falls, where she graduated from Idaho Falls High School.

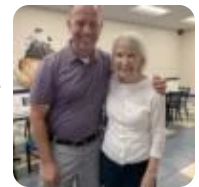
