Sharon Lee Crow passed away November 24, 2025 in Salt Lake City, UT. Sharon was born December 12, 1939 in Kirkwood, MO, the first daughter to Rod and Lee Edson. The family moved to Corpus Christi, TX where she graduated from W.B. Ray High School in 1957. In 1962 she received her Bachelor's degree in Education from Texas A&I in Kingsville, TX, and completed her Master's in Special Education from the University of Houston in 1975.

She married her first husband, Robert Pickens, in Corpus Christi in 1962 and they had two children, Paige and Kyle. She met and married her second husband, Kenneth Crow, in 1975 while living in Victoria, TX. Ken had two sons from a previous marriage, Jason and Gordon Crow, to whom Sharon was a loving stepmother.
