Daniel “Dan” Lemmon, age 68, of Riverdale, Utah, passed away on December 4, 2025.

He was born on July 24, 1957, in Ogden, Utah to Duane Alfred Lemmon and Wanda Lanae Lemmon (Atkinson). Growing up Dan had many fond memories of attending Lorin Farr Elementary and Central Jr. High School in Ogden. His family moved from Ogden to Roy where he graduated from Roy High School in 1975. Upon graduation Dan went on to enlist in the United States Navy. He was an aircraft engine mechanic on the P3 Orion aircraft. He was stationed at Barbers Point Naval Air Station in Oahu, Hawaii and traveled to many exotic places around the world. His service to his country was one of his greatest sources of pride.

After being honorably discharged from the Navy, Dan went on to have a successful career as a jet engine mechanic in the assembly and test department at Williams International in Ogden, Utah until his retirement.
