Preceded in death by LeRoy (father), Pearl (mother), Darrell Miller (brother), Jana Atwood (sister), and baby boy Miller (brother).

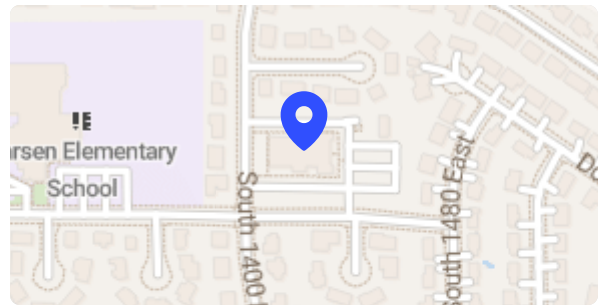
