John was proceeded in death by his father, mother, oldest brother (Nicholas Kepros), and a dear partner (Daye Abbott). John was survived by his older brother (Peter George Kepros).

John was married to Karen Sue Scholl in September of 1994, then Divorced July of 1997. Later in life John reconnected with a dear friend and partner Daye Abbott. He spent many years with her and cherished her company until her passing in October of 2022. 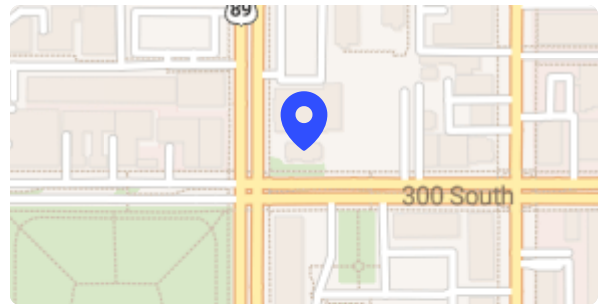

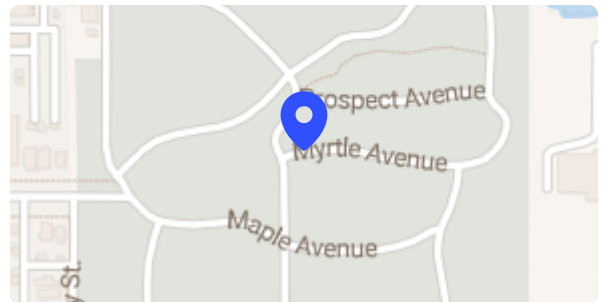
