**R**onda Lyn Jones, 75, Riverton, Utah, passed away on March 2, 2026 at The Peaks in South Jordan, Utah.

Born on August 4, 1950, in Oakland, CA to Reo Robbins and Rosemary Frances Worthington. Ronda graduated from Skyline High School and went on to get a Bachelor's degree in History at the University of Utah. She married in 1972 and adopted Allen Jr. as her own, then had two children Ryan and Farrah.

She was a woman of remarkable strength and determination, always willing to do whatever was necessary to care for her family.
