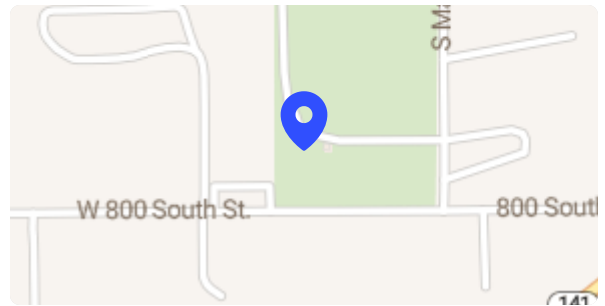

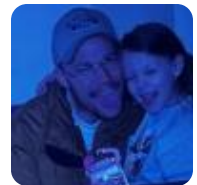
Ben Bishop posted:

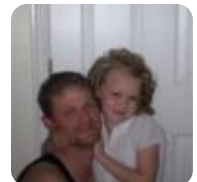
