Interment: Mountain View Cemetery, Eden, Utah.



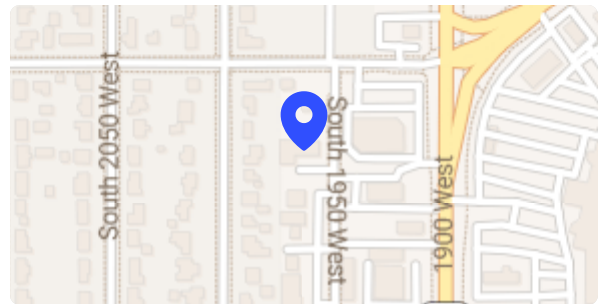

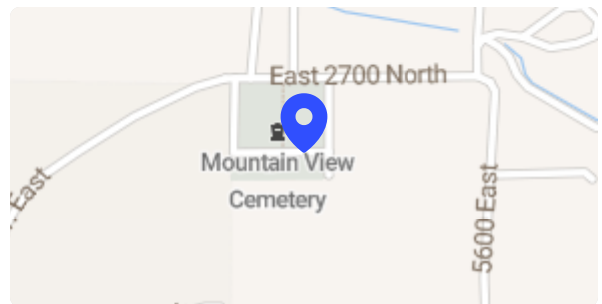

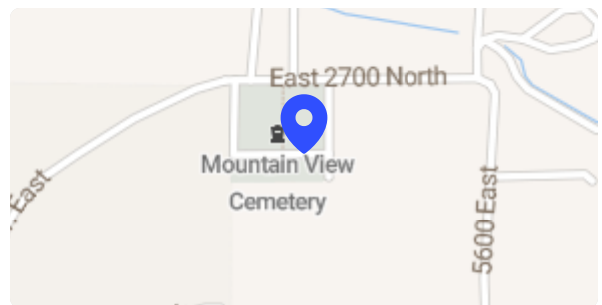
