They were married on November 14, 1997, and later sealed for time and all eternity in the Ogden Temple. They raised a family of 3 wonderful daughters, who are extremely lucky to be a part of such a fun-loving family.

Dyanna is a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. She served faithfully in so many callings including the ward organist and pianist, Primary, Young Women and Relief Society.
