Hank was hard working and was employed with various companies early in his years but found his career as a store/sales manager for Pyke Mfg Co. from which he retired after 25 years. He also spent 10 years as a courier for Bank of American after his retirement.

After retiring Hank and Marge started traveling over the Western United States and ended up being snowbirds in Yuma, Arizona several months each year.

In his final years he spent time working in the yard, walks with his dog, Coco, in the park, and enjoyed receiving visits from his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Hank is survived by his two children Michelle (Steve) of Ferron UT, Dave (Cindy) of Provo UT, 11 grandchildren and 30 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his son R. Scott Clements of Casper, WY.
